A seed develops under each floret and the flower transforms into a seed head.



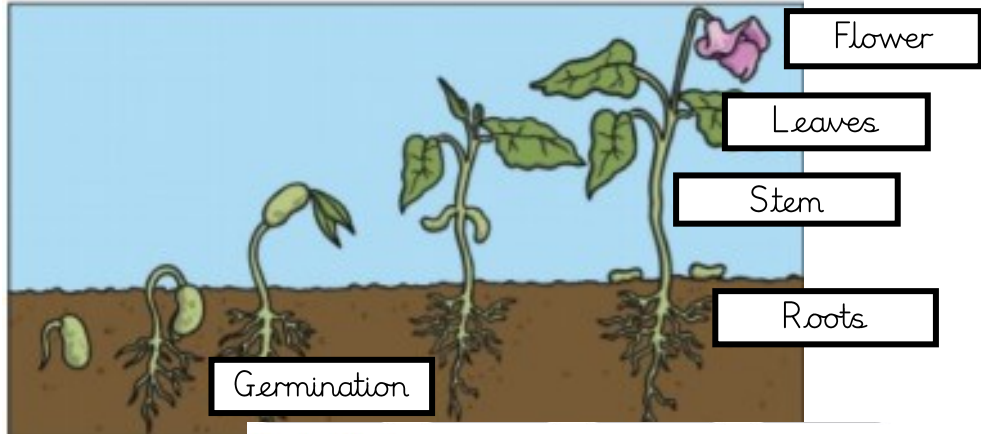
Seeds are dispersed by the wind

Key Vocabulary

wild plants	It doesn't need to be planted or cared for as it grows
garden plants	Plants that people choose to grow in their gardens
seed 	Seeds are the small parts produced by plants from which new plants grow.
bulb 	an underground resting stage of a plant
germination	The tiny new plant bursts out of its shell
fruit	Fruit contains the plants seeds
roots	roots take in water and nutrients from the soil and keep the plant in the ground
stem	The stem <u>hold</u> the plant up
flower	Flowers attract insects and birds
leaves	Leaves catch sunlight to help the plant make its own food
