Dear Parents and Carers - Reverse Advent Calendar

As we approach the festive season, I am excited to tell you a wonderful initiative we will be participating in again this year: a Reverse Advent Calendar.

Traditionally, an advent calendar counts down the days until Christmas by offering a small treat each day. In contrast, our Reverse Advent Calendar encourages us to give back to our community. Instead of receiving, we will be donating items to our local food bank, helping those in need during this special time of year. This is instead of asking you to bring in items at Harvest time.

How It Works: We invite each family to bring in one non-perishable food item each week throughout December if you can. Here's the schedule:

Week 1 (November 24 - 28): Canned goods (e.g., vegetables, soups)

Week 2 (December 1 - 5): Toiletries (shower gel, shampoo, handwash)

Week 3 (December 8 - 12): Snacks (e.g., biscuits, cakes, dried fruit)

Please send your contributions to school on the designated days, and we will collect them for the food bank. This is a fantastic opportunity for our children to learn about generosity and the importance of helping others.
